We require individuals to work on a casual basis during our busy examination periods. Hours are flexible by agreement.

Invigilators will be required to assist in the supervision of students taking examinations and will ensure that they are conducted in accordance with regulatory requirements.

Working as a team, invigilators contribute to ensuring a calm environment for the exams, giving candidate's confidence in the process. The public examination period is May and June,

however, Invigilators will be required to attend during the year for training and to assist with internal exams.

Readers/Scribes are required to support individual students by reading aloud and/or transcribing verbal answers to examination questions. Good spoken and written English are essential for this role.

Previous experience of invigilation would be advantageous but not essential. You must be reliable and punctual, highly flexible, able to relate to learners of all abilities and be comfortable in a high-pressure environment. It's a part-time role, but one that can make a real difference.
